'Explore America' Honors the Centennial of the National Park Service In the Flower Show's acres of trails, exhibits and attractions, guests will discover the range of horticulture in the national landscape, including the rainbow of wildflowers, desert blooms, coastal flora, verdant meadows, fragrant pinelands, and ancient redwoods. The Flower Show will also tell the diverse stories that forged the United States with exhibits inspired by the nation's monuments and places where history happened. "Explore America" will spotlight Independence National Historical Park, Lincoln's birthplace, Liberty Island, and other sites honoring our national heritage.

The PHS Philadelphia Flower Show is an annual event at the Pennsylvania Convention Center in March. It is the world's oldest and largest indoor flower show, attracting more than 260,000 people annually. The Show features large-scale gardens, elaborate landscapes, and over-the-top floral creations.
