Trash and Recycling Notice

Due to today's weather event no trash or recycling will be picked up Wednesday, August 5th. Tuesdays and Wednesdays (or part of) will be picked up beginning Thursday, August 6 and we will continue through the week and work on Saturday, August 8 until we complete the routes. Please note some areas of the city have faced significant damages and those areas may not be picked up this week. Debris removal will continue for many weeks as we are assessing the damages throughout Dover.

Do not mix yard waste/debris with your trash. We will NOT pick up.

Downtown Dover Tuesday night trash will be picked up Wednesday, August 5.

Our staff is working to get Dover cleaned up and resuming normal activities. Please be patient with our crews and staff. Allowing crew members to work without interruption on the job site is greatly appreciated and reduces the time needed to complete tasks.

We are actively working with Delaware Emergency Management Service and the National Weather Service to determine exactly what many of our residents experienced. Again, please be patient while assessments are completed.
