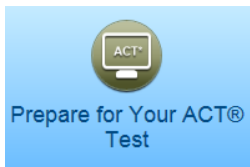


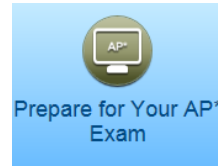
Course Offerings



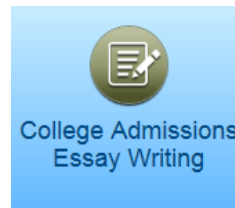
The “**Prepare for Your SAT**” course offers tutorials, practice exams, and eBooks to help students prepare for the SAT as well as specific SAT subjects. The tutorials include interactive lessons and practice exercises, which review all the key concepts you need to know and test your knowledge along the way. The practice exams are available in a *timed simulation mode*, a *practice mode* that explains your incorrect answers, or a *learner mode* that provides explanations while you answer exam questions. Instructive eBooks are available for various SAT subjects.



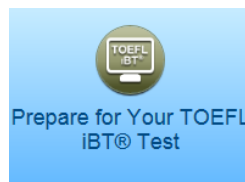
The “**Prepare for Your ACT Test**” course offers tutorials, practice exams, and eBooks to help students prepare for the ACT and specific ACT subjects.



The “**Prepare for Your AP Exam**” course offers practice exams and eBooks to help students prepare for specific AP exams. The practice exams are available in the same three modes described for the SAT practice. **AP subjects** include **biology, calculus, chemistry, English language, English literature, European history, psychology, US Government & Politics, and US History.**



The “**College Admissions Essay Writing**” component offers two eBooks on writing, revising, and editing college admission essays.



The “**Prepare for your TOEFL iBT Test**” offers eBooks and practice tests for the listening, reading, speaking, and writing sections of the tests.

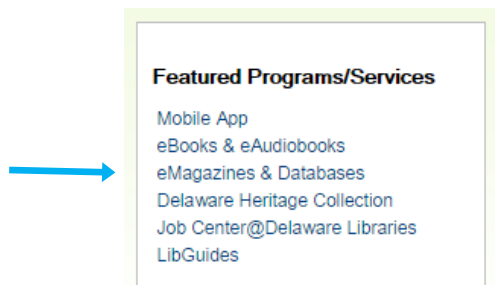
- A computer with Internet access

Registering with Learning Express

You will be prompted to enter your 14-digit library card number and your 4-digit PIN. If forgotten, your PIN can only be requested in person at the library.

Once you arrive at the Learning Express homepage, make sure to log-in or register an account.

The "login" and "register" links are in the top right corner of the homepage. You will need an email account in order to register an account.

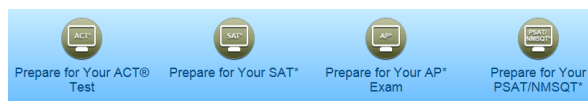
TIP: write down the email account and password you used, so that you can access your saved progress with Learning Express.

After clicking the "College Prep Center" link, you must scroll through the different class options and select the test prep you want.

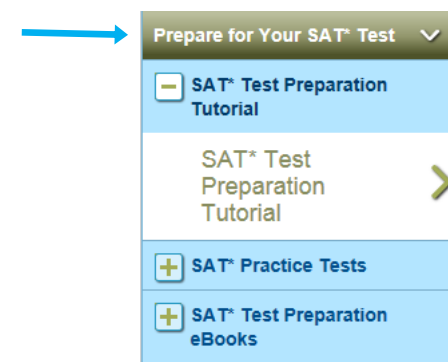


Navigating the Courses

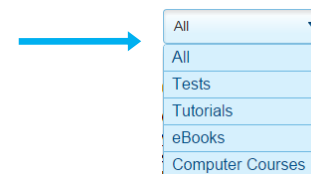
Select a course, such as "Prepare for Your SAT."
