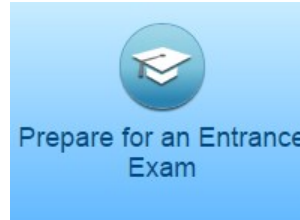


## Course Offerings



### Under “Prepare for an Occupation Exam”

- Select “**Nursing**” to locate practice exams, flash reviews, and eBooks for nursing occupation exams such as the **NCLEX-RN, NCLEX-PN, and Nursing Assistant / Nurse Aide.**
- Select “**Allied Health**” to locate practice exams, flash reviews, and eBooks for occupation exams such as **Dental Assisting, Medical Assistant, Pharmacy Technician, Physical Therapist Assistant, Radiologic Technologist, Surgical Technologist, and Veterinary Technician.**
- Select “**Emergency Medical Services**” to locate practice exams, flash reviews, and eBooks for occupation exams such as **EMT Certification and Paramedic Certification.**



The “Prepare for an Entrance Exam” component offers practice exams and eBooks for **Nursing School Entrance Exams (TEAS, NET, HESI, APNE, RNSAE)**. Topics such as biology, chemistry, general science, math ability, reading comprehension, and verbal ability are covered.

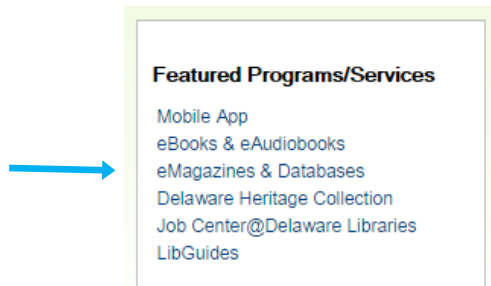
- A computer with Internet access

## Registering with Learning Express

You will be prompted to enter your 14-digit library card number and your 4-digit PIN. If forgotten, your PIN can only be requested in person at the library.

Once you arrive at the Learning Express homepage, make sure to log-in or register an account.

The "login" and "register" links are in the top right corner of the homepage. You will need an email account in order to register an account.

TIP: write down the email account and password you used, so that you can access your saved progress with Learning Express.

Scroll through the different learning options and click on "Career Center."

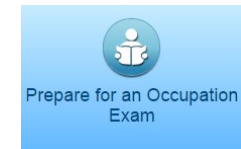


After clicking the "Career Center" link, you must scroll through the different class options and select the course you want.

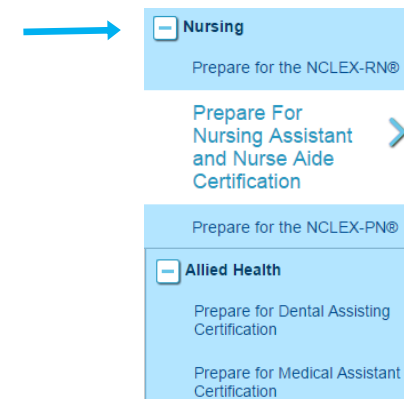


## Navigating the Courses

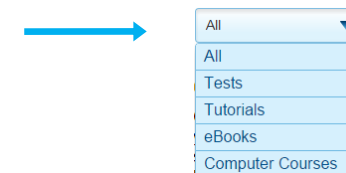
Select a course, such as "Prepare for an Occupation Exam."



After selecting a course, you will be able to view and select from more specific course topics. Look at the specific course topics in the top left corner of the screen.



Each specific course topic offers instructional resources such as tests, tutorials, eBooks, and computer courses. Click on the dropdown bar to see the instructional resources offered.
