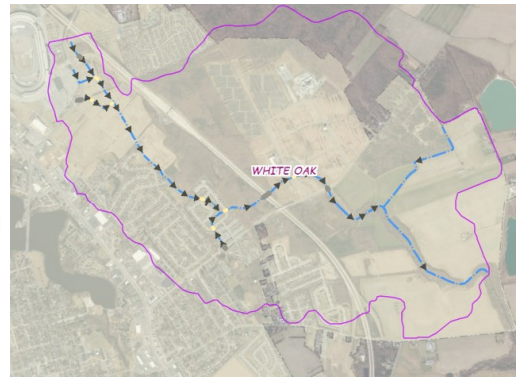

### Annual Meeting Recap

The White Oak Tax Ditch Annual Meeting was held on Monday, February 9, 2026, at City Hall. Danny Tartt (Kent Conservation District, KCD) was in attendance to answer questions. The meeting featured updates on completed maintenance and projects, planned projects, and answering citizen drainage questions. After the meeting, Public Works met with Danny Tartt to investigate a

drainage complaint raised by a citizen in the meeting, and to evaluate a segment of the ditch for dip-out. The City will apply in June for KCD Cost-Share to complete both of these projects. 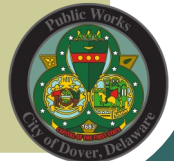
