



SENATOR BIKEWAY NO PARKING SIGNS

Dear Valued City of Dover Residents,

The City of Dover, in conjunction with the Delaware Department of Transportation (DelDOT), would like to inform the public about the proposed pedestrian and bicycle improvements on W. Division Street and N. West Street from Weston Drive to Cecil Street. This Transportation Alternatives project will include the following proposed improvements:

- Replace existing deteriorated concrete sidewalk with a 5' wide proposed concrete sidewalk along the north side of W. Division Street and the west side of N. West Street, from Weston Drive to Fulton Street.
- Remove on-street parking and install a new two-way, on-street, protected bike lane within the existing shoulder on the north side of W. Division Street and the west side of N. West Street, from Weston Drive to Cecil Street.
- Replace existing curb with new curb and gutter where required within the project limits.
- Upgrade existing curb ramps to meet current ADA requirements.

An exhibit on the extent of this project is on the opposite side of this page for your convenience. On behalf of the City of Dover Department of Public Works, we would like to sincerely thank you for your cooperation with this improvement project. This project is scheduled to start in the Spring of 2019, with completion in the summer of 2019. The City will be installing the no parking signs in advance of the project, we anticipate putting up the signs by the middle of February.
